TRAIL RULES & REGULATIONS

Trail is monitored and rules strictly enforced

TRAIL HOURS: Open Sunrise to Sunset

Tornado Trail is adjacent to the Concordia Preserve. **DO NOT ENTER THE PRESERVE.** Stay on designated trails and within designated recreational areas at all times. Follow the trail markers.

Endangered and sensitive wildlife utilize this habitat; please enjoy trails quietly and respectfully.

Hiking, trail running and mountain biking are permitted.

Use the trails with respect and courtesy for other users.

Respect plants & wildlife – do not approach animals, remove vegetation, or damage or deface natural features. Watch for venomous snakes and poison ivy!

Leave no trace – pack it in, pack it out. Please do not litter.

Minors should be accompanied by an adult.

All pets must be leashed at all times. Clean up after your pet.

Wear appropriate clothing and shoes. Carry plenty of water.

Trails are not manicured, so watch your step. Watch for trip hazards on the trail.

Pedestrians have the right-of-way.
