CTX Landscape facts:

- Our campus grass mix includes Buffalo Grass, Blue Grama and Curly Mesquite.
 - These types of grass are native to Texas and require no irrigation once established.
 - We have saved \$128,000 annually on watering by using limited irrigation and drought resistant, natural grasses and wildflowers.
 - The wildflower mix on campus includes: Texas Bluebonnets, Huisache Daises, Lemon Mint, Indian Blankets, Greenthreads, Lazy Daises, Prairie Verbana and White Winecups.
